- Each member to be approved by Exec Committee
 - No voting rights
- Membership may not be used as an endorsement on your signature or used as a hand therapy qualification

Maintenance

- Payment of annual subscription fee

Affiliate member of HTNZ

- A Registered Hand Therapist who is currently non practising
- Each member to be approved by Exec Committee
 - No voting rights

- HTNZ members conference rates
- Streamlined re-entry into Registered membership for first 4 years of Affiliate membership

Maintenance

- Payment of annual subscription fee
- Accrue a minimum of 45 points per log book cycle
